

2012 TLBT SENIOR HEIFER SALE

General Information & Contract

The TLBT Senior Heifer Sale allows a small group of graduating seniors (usually up to five), to sell an animal of their choice at the World Show each year. If more than five youth have expressed an interest in the Senior Heifer Sale, five names will be drawn at random by an objective party. Participants are required to read the general information and sign the contract below.

Eligibility & Requirements

- Youth participants must be current, paid members of the TLBT for a minimum of two years.
- Participants must be a graduating high school senior from an accredited high school or an approved home school curriculum in the spring of 2012.
- Participants may only sell one animal.
- Participants must submit a portfolio to the committee before the 2012 TLBT World Show. The portfolio must include an essay on what the TLBT has done for you, what your plans are for the future, and how you have marketed your animal. It must also include a copy of the animal's registration papers and at least two pictures of you and your animal.
- The animal you sell may be registered in your name, but that is not a requirement. It may be in a ranch name, your parent's name, your grandparent's name, or the name of someone who has donated the animal to you for this sale.
- The animal you plan to sell must have qualified for and entered in the 2012 TLBT World Show.
- All animals will be sold for the amount of the bid. There will be no PO's.
- Of the Senior participants, one Senior will be selected based on their marketing skills. The winner will be given a prize for "Senior Marketing Champion."
- All contracts must be submitted to the TLBAA Office by the deadline March 31, **2012**.

Recommendations

- Seniors may enter a heifer, steer or bull, but females are recommended.
- Participants are encouraged to seek bidders for your animal before the sale. This should be mentioned in your portfolio. This may be done through e-mail, texts, phone calls, mail, promotion at sales and shows, or any other avenue.
- It is recommended that the animal you choose to sell be young enough that it could be shown in the following show season.

All participants will be considered, regardless of applicant's socio-economic status, race, color, sex, religion, national origin or disability.
