Frequently Asked Questions

Q: **What time does the Sale start?**

A: 11:00 am Saturday Morning.

Q: **When do cattle need to arrive?**

A: Registered cattle need to start arriving at 12:00 Friday and no later than 5:00 to be catalogued; Commercial cattle can arrive through Saturday morning no later than 9:00 a.m.

Q: **What do we need to bring?**

A: Original Registration Certificate, Transfer Application, and Consignment form filled out and signed. Trichomoniasis Tests, or Virgin Status Certificate.

Q: **What are the requirements for Health Papers?**

A: Only cattle that come from outside the State of Texas need health papers. Breeding age bulls need a Trichomoniasis test; virgin bulls need to be certified.

Q: **What are the fees for the Sale?**

A: **Yardage:** \$6 per animal

Beef Check-off: \$1 per animal

Palpation: \$6.50, per breeder's request

Branding: \$25 if required, to be paid at the time of Branding to West Auction

Vet charges: All cattle 18 mos + that are sexually intact – \$4.50 Brucellosis test is required by State of Texas for change of ownership

Q: **Where is the Sale located?**

A: West Auction Barn centrally located between Waco and Fort Worth on I-35, Exit 351

Q: **When is the next Sale?**

A: August 7, 2010 Pre-Catalog Deadline: June 9, 2010

December 4, 2010 Pre-Catalog Deadline: October 6, 2010

Q: **What time do they start the Social on Friday?**

A: The Friday night Social starts between 5:00-6:00 p.m.

P.O. Seller will be responsible for consignment, yardage, vet and any additional charges.
