The Dube Chute has a palpation gate on each side, gates to squeeze a mature cow or a baby calf with no adjustments, branding let downs for access, fold down table for medicine, and works great for loading and unloading cattle.

Mr. Bob Dube will have a chute at the TLBT World

Show for delivery, but can exchange it for a different one if you brand your cattle on the opposite side as it is set up for.
